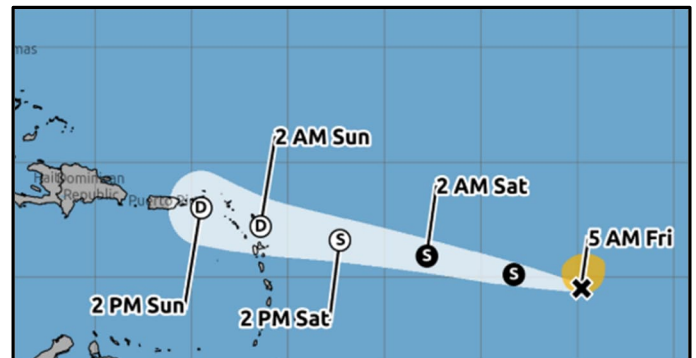
Flash Flood Threat Southeast U.S.

- Starting Friday, an area of high pressure will push the cold front that's producing severe weather in the Northeast into the Southeast.
- Friday's flood threat shifts east, with a Level 2 out of 4 centered over the Carolinas. The front will eventually slow down, which will keep the same areas under a threat for flash flooding all the way through Sunday.
- A Level 1 out of 4 flash flood risk stretches across the Southeast from Virginia to Florida and Louisiana on Saturday.
- By the end of the week, at least 1 to 3 inches of rain will likely have fallen for most of the Southeast.



Tropical Activity – Atlantic Tropical Storm Dolly

- Located 1145 miles east of the Leeward Islands.
- Maximum sustained winds at 40 mph.
- Dolly is moving quickly toward the west near 24 mph and this motion is expected to continue for the next couple of days.
- Little change in strength is likely during the next couple of days, and Dolly is forecast to degenerate into a tropical wave before it reaches the Leeward Islands.



Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific Tropical Storm Lowell

- Located 1565 miles ESE of Hilo Hawaii.
- Maximum sustained winds of 45 mph.
- Lowell is moving toward the east-northeast near 6 mph (9 km/h).
- A turn toward the west is expected by Saturday, with that motion continuing into early next week.
- Strengthening is likely during the next several days, and Lowell is forecast to become a hurricane over the weekend.

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Tropical Storm Karina

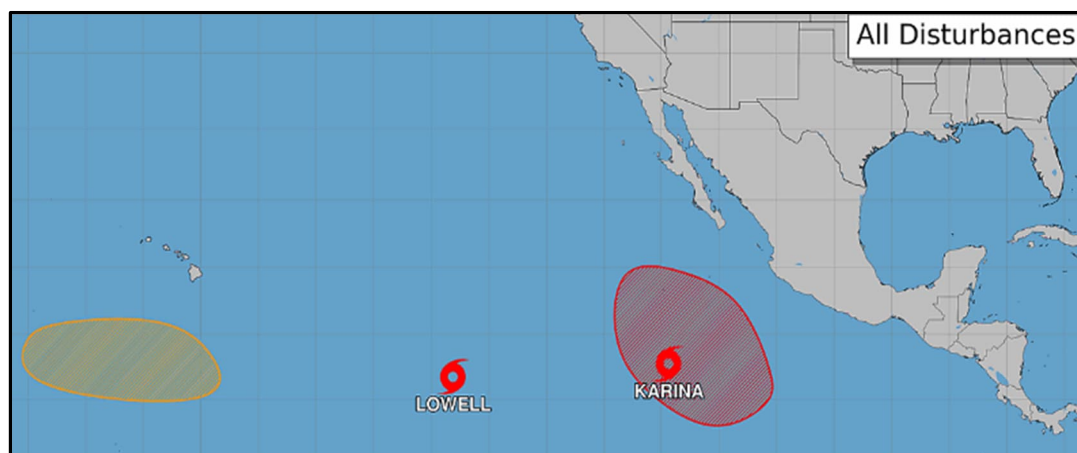
- Located about 760 miles SSW of the southern tip of Baja California.
- Maximum sustained winds at 50 mph.
- Karina is moving toward the northwest near 13 mph (20 km/h) and this general motion is expected to continue over the next couple of days followed by a turn more westward.
- Strengthening is forecast and Karina is likely to become a hurricane over the weekend.
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 230 miles from the center.

Disturbance 1

- Area of low pressure is forecast to form this weekend well into the south of the southwestern Mexico.
- Conditions appear favorable for gradual development and a tropical depression is likely to form early next week.
- Moving WNW to NW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: High (80%)

Disturbance 2

- An area of low pressure could form well south of southwest of the Hawaiian Islands in a few days.
- Gradual development is possible thereafter and a tropical depression could form during the middle part of next week.
- Moving slowly WNW well offshore of the Hawaiian Islands.
- Formation chance – 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Med (40%)
