

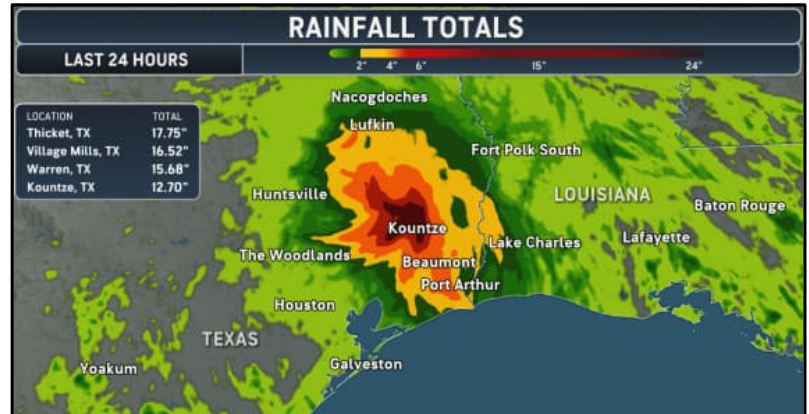
# DAILY DART

WSP USA FIELD SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

September 3, 2026

## Tropical Activity – Atlantic Tropical Depression Edouard

- The remnants of Edouard are swamping Southeast Texas with heavy rain and flash flooding and has left more than 40,000 customers without power as it slowly makes its way inland.
- A Flash Flood Emergency was issued for Hardin County, Texas, Wednesday night just to the southwest of Kountze. The storm system has already dropped 3 to 7 inches, with another 2 to 5 inches possible, according to the FOX Forecast Center.
- A Flash Flood Emergency resulting in life-threatening flooding was also issued for parts of Hardin and Tyler counties early Wednesday, while some counties, including Polk County, issued a disaster declaration following severe weather impacts overnight.
- Edouard made landfall as a tropical storm near Johnson Bayou, Louisiana, about 15 miles south-southeast of Port Arthur, Texas, at 2:20 p.m. local time on Tuesday, packing maximum sustained winds of 60 mph and a minimum central pressure of 996 mb, according to the National Hurricane Center (NHC).
- The system is moving west-northwest at about 5 mph, a motion expected to continue until dissipation.
- Maximum sustained winds are near 25 mph, with higher gusts.
- Slow weakening to dissipation is forecast over the next 24 hours.
- The National Weather Service said 10 to 21 inches of rain fell across the area covered by the Flash Flood Emergency early Wednesday morning and urged people in the Kountze, Village Mills and Honey Island communities to seek higher ground immediately.
- Edouard was downgraded to a tropical depression Tuesday night and weakened to a remnant area of low pressure early Thursday.
- Edouard's remnants will remain a flood threat for East Texas through Thursday morning.



## Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific Hurricane Lowell (CAT 4)

- Located 450 miles south of Hilo, Hawaii moving W at 10 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 145 mph.
- Some fluctuations in intensity are expected during the next few days. However, Lowell is expected to remain a major hurricane for the next several days.
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 40 miles from the center and tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 105 miles.

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## Hurricane Marie (CAT 1)

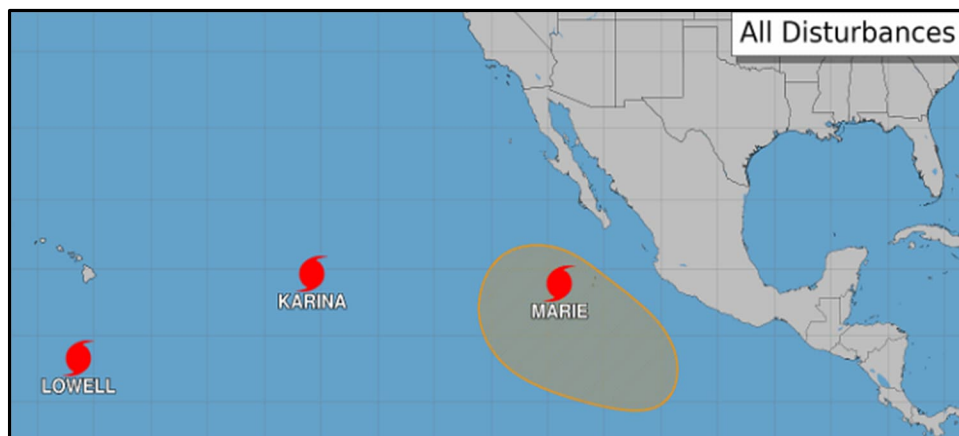
- Located 380 miles southwest of the southern tip of Baja California moving WNW at 10 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 85 mph.
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend up to 185 miles outward from center.
- Some strengthening is forecast during the next 48 hours, and gradual weakening is anticipated to begin by this weekend.
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 40 miles from the center and tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 205 miles.

## Hurricane Karina (CAT 3)

- Located 1,260 miles east of Hilo Hawaii moving WNW at 12 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 120 mph.
- Hurricane-force winds up to 35 miles out from center.
- Gradual weakening is forecast during the next several days. However, Karina is expected to remain a hurricane for the next couple of days.
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 35 miles from the center and tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 125 miles.

## Disturbance 1

- An area of low pressure could form well offshore of southwestern Mexico over the weekend or early next week.
- Gradual development is possible, and the system could become a tropical depression around the middle of next week.
- Moving WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Med (40%)
