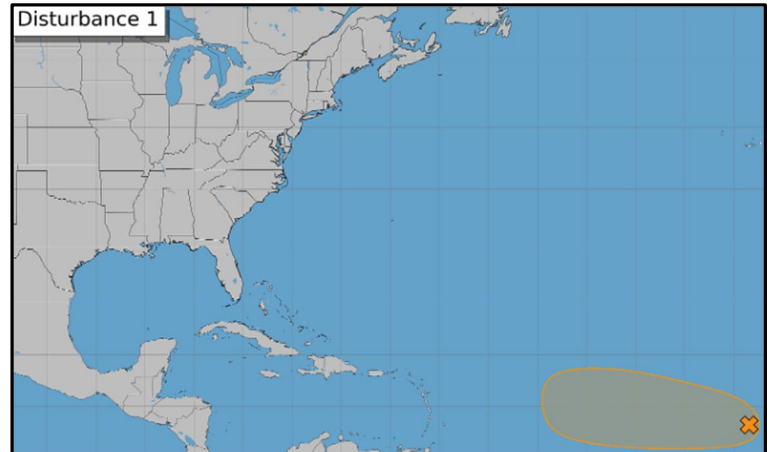

Tropical Activity – Atlantic

Disturbance 1

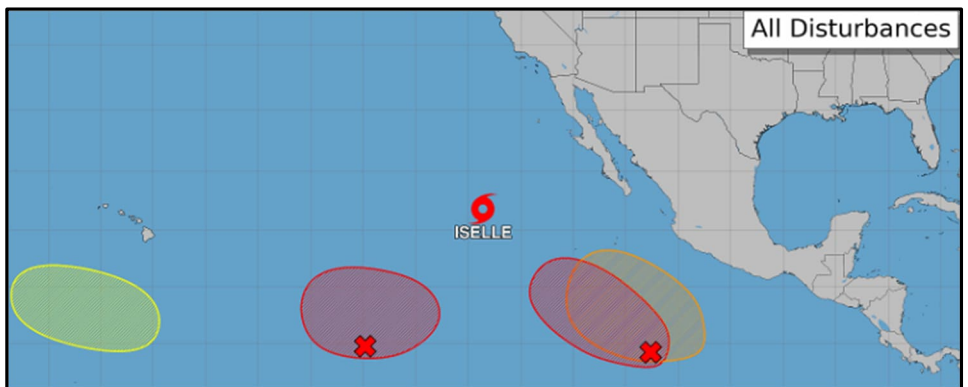
- Located a few hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands.
- Moving westward to WNW across the eastern and central tropical Atlantic.
- Conditions are somewhat favorable for development over the next couple of days, and a tropical depression could form over the next day or two.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Medium (60%); 7-day: Medium (60%)



Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific

Tropical Storm Iselle

- Located 870 mi west of the southern tip of Baja California moving WNW at 9 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 50 mph.
- Steady weakening is expected, and Iselle is forecast to become a post-tropical remnant low by early Thursday.



Disturbance 1

- Located well to the south of southwestern Mexico moving WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Conditions are expected to support gradual development of this system and a tropical depression is likely to form during the next day or so.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (80%); 7-day: High (90%)

Disturbance 2

- Located well to the ESE of the Hawaiian Islands.
- A tropical depression is likely to form late this week or early this weekend while the system drifts to the NE, then turns westward.
- Formation chance – 48 hours: Med (40%); 7 days: High (70%)

Disturbance 3

- Located well offshore Southwestern Mexico.
- A tropical depression could form by early next week while it moves westward to WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance – 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Med (60%)

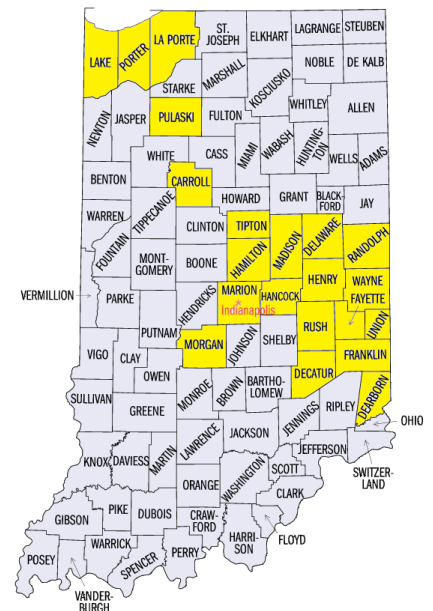
Disturbance 4

- An area of low pressure could form well south of the Hawaiian Islands late this week or over the weekend.
- Some gradual development is possible by early next week while the system moves slowly WNW, well south southwest of the Hawaiian Islands.
- Formation chance – 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Low (20%)

Disaster Declaration Activity

DR-4933 Indiana

- Federal disaster aid is on the way to Hoosiers and communities across storm-battered Indiana after President Donald Trump approved the state's request for a major disaster declaration on August 25th.
- The declaration makes individual assistance available in 21 counties and public assistance available in 11, Braun's office announced Tuesday. Additional counties could be added as state and federal officials continue reviewing damage.
- The approval follows severe storms, tornadoes, a derecho and flooding that began Aug. 11. Braun's request reported eight deaths, three documented injuries and hundreds of evacuations. Power outages peaked at 363,398 homes and businesses across Indiana.
- At least 44 structures were destroyed, 959 sustained major damage, 520 had minor damage and another 217 were otherwise affected, according to the governor's filing.
- Carroll, Dearborn, Decatur, Delaware, Fayette, Franklin, Hamilton, Hancock, Henry, Lake, LaPorte, Madison, Marion, Morgan, Porter, Pulaski, Randolph, Rush, Tipton, Union and Wayne counties were approved for individual assistance.
