

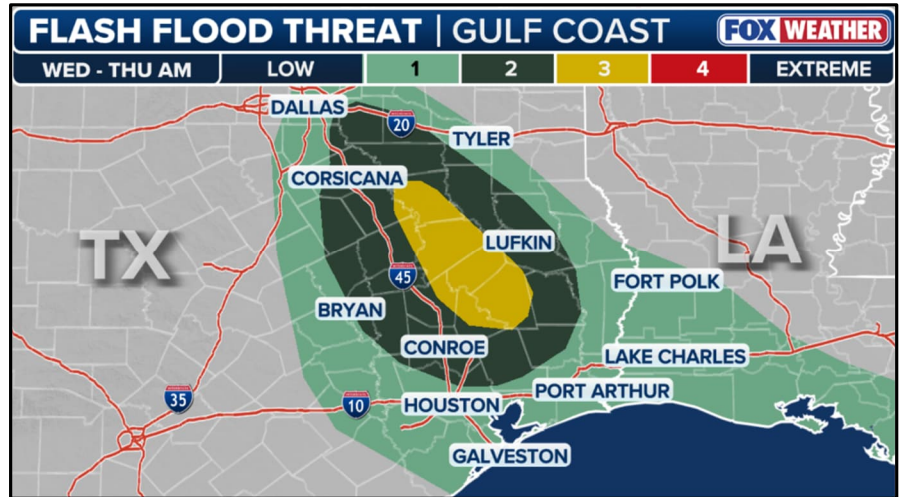

WSP USA FIELD SERVICES DISASTER AWARENESS REPORT

September 2, 2026

## Tropical Activity – Atlantic Tropical Depression Edouard

- Tropical Depression Edouard is swamping South-east Texas with heavy rain and flash flooding and has left more than 70,000 customers without power as it slowly makes its way inland.
- A Flash Flood Emergency for life-threatening flooding was issued for parts of Hardin and Tyler counties shortly after 5:45 a.m. local time.
- Edouard made landfall as a tropical storm near Johnson Bayou, Louisiana, about 15 miles south-southeast of Port Arthur, Texas, at 2:20 p.m. local time, packing maximum sustained winds of 60 mph and a minimum central pressure of 996 mb, according to the National Hurricane Center (NHC).
- Edouard was downgraded to a tropical depression at 10 p.m. Tuesday.
- The National Weather Service said 10 to 21 inches of rain have fallen across the area covered by the Flash Flood Emergency as of early Wednesday and urged people in the Kountze, Village Mills and Honey Island communities to seek higher ground immediately.
- A Flood Watch remains in effect for much of the region through Wednesday evening, including Houston, while a Flash Flood Warning was in effect early Wednesday for Hardin, Jefferson, Tyler, Chambers, Liberty, Polk and San Jacinto counties.
- Both the city and Jefferson County issued disaster declarations ahead of the storm to help speed up anticipated cleanup.
- According to the FOX Forecast Center, the heaviest rain will fall inland in Texas through midday Wednesday as the storm's center moves inland, somewhat paralleling the Interstate 45 corridor.



## Tropical Activity – Eastern & Central Pacific Hurricane Lowell (CAT 4)

- Located 470 miles SSE of Hilo, Hawaii moving W at 12 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 145 mph.
- Lowell could further strengthen on Wednesday and is expected to remain a powerful hurricane for the rest of the work week.
- Hurricane-force winds extend outward up to 35 miles from the center and tropical-storm-force winds extend outward up to 90 miles

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## Tropical Storm Marie

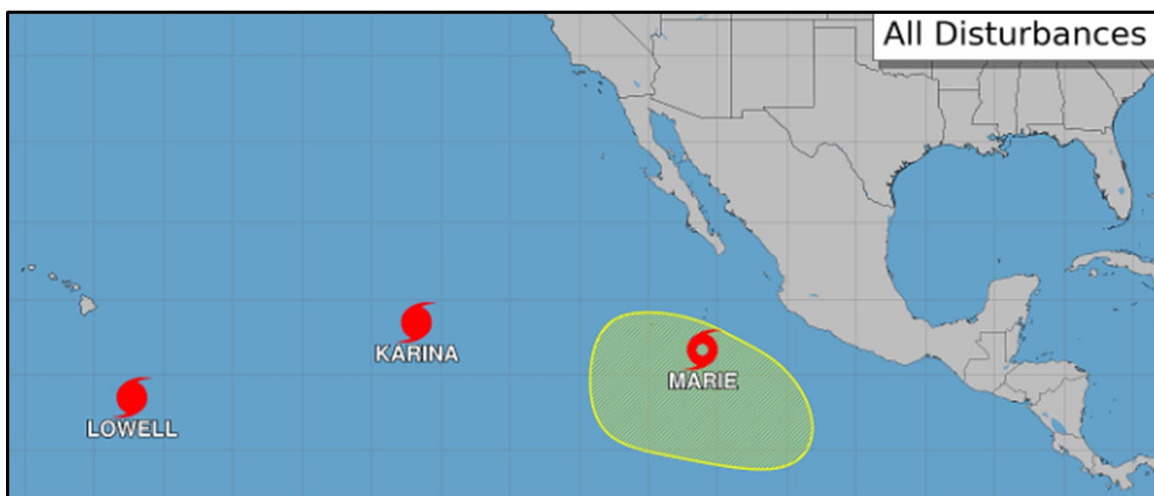
- Located 435 miles south of the southern tip of Baja California moving NW at 10 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 65 mph.
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend up to 185 miles outward from center.
- A turn toward the west-northwest is expected later today, and that motion should continue through Friday.
- Some strengthening is forecast during the next 48 hours, and Marie is likely to become a hurricane later today.

## Hurricane Karina (CAT 4)

- Located 1,440 miles west of the southern tip of Baja California moving west at near 12 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 145 mph.
- Hurricane-force winds up to 35 miles out from center.
- Tropical-storm-force winds up to 125 miles out from center.
- Some additional strengthening is possible through Wednesday morning, followed by slow weakening over the next several days. However, Karina is likely to remain a major hurricane into Thursday.

## Disturbance 1

- An area of low pressure could form well offshore of southwestern Mexico over the weekend.
- Gradual development is possible early next week.
- Moving WNW at 10 to 15 mph.
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%); 7 days: Low (20%)
