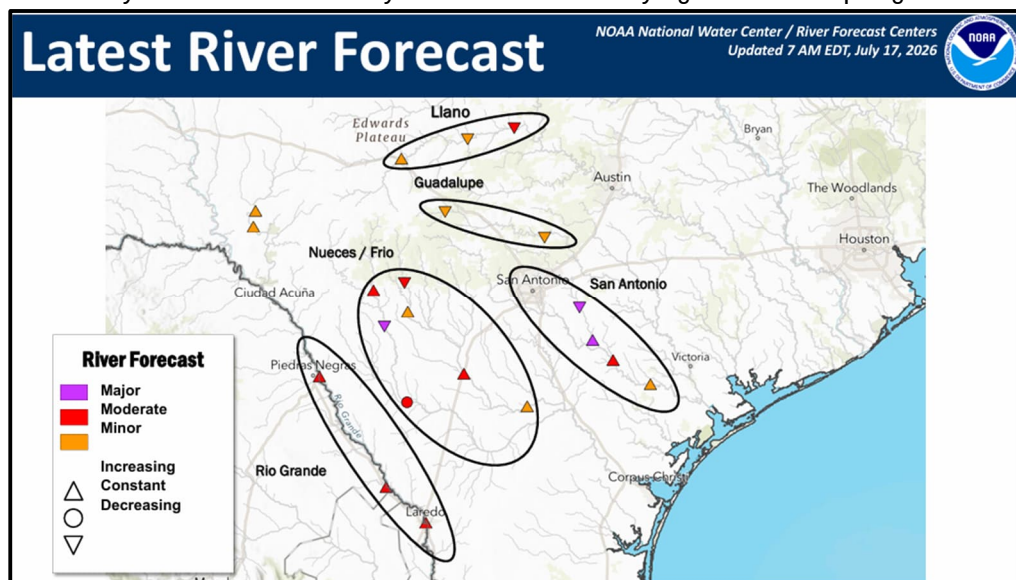

July 17, 2026

## Flood Activity

### Texas

- Disastrous flash flooding has hit southern Texas after days of torrential rain, leaving at least two people dead and hundreds of people rescued across the same region struck by last July's catastrophic floods.
- More than 230 rescues have been made so far, Texas Gov. Greg Abbott said Thursday afternoon, adding more than 85 boats, 20 aircraft and 200 high-profile vehicles have been deployed to assist the response.
- About a year's worth of rain has fallen in parts of southern Texas this week, but the forecast is now improving in the hardest-hit areas. Isolated showers remain possible, but the threat of additional significant rainfall has, for the most part, ended.
- Today's flash flood threat will instead focus on areas farther west from San Angelo and Junction to El Paso, all of which have not seen nearly as much rain this week.
- Moderate to major riverine flooding is also ongoing or expected in an area from the Rio Grande to Llano and San Antonio watersheds.
- A Flood Warning is in effect for the Pedernales River at Johnson City until Friday afternoon.
- A Flood Watch remains in effect for Blanco, Gillespie, Llano, Mason and San Saba counties until 12 p.m. Friday.
- Mandatory and voluntary evacuations are active for low-lying areas in Uvalde.
- Maverick County has issued a voluntary evacuation for the Elm Creek area and a mandatory evacuation for Quemado and Normandy.
- City of Bandera ordered a mandatory evacuation for residents of the Riverside RV Park.
- Comal County ordered a mandatory evacuation for low-lying areas near Spring Branch.



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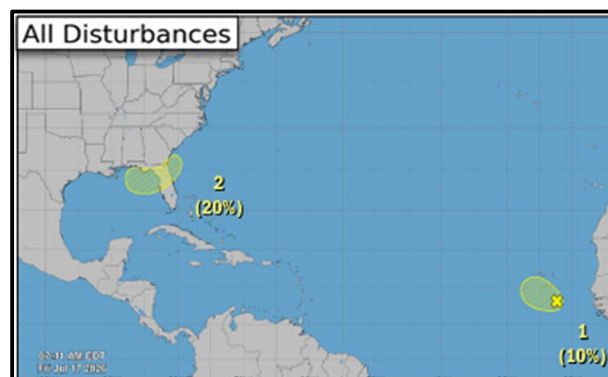
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## Tropical Activity – Atlantic

### Disturbance 1

- Located SE of the Cabo Verde Islands moving WNW at 10-15 mph.
- Forecast to move into a less conducive environment by this weekend.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)



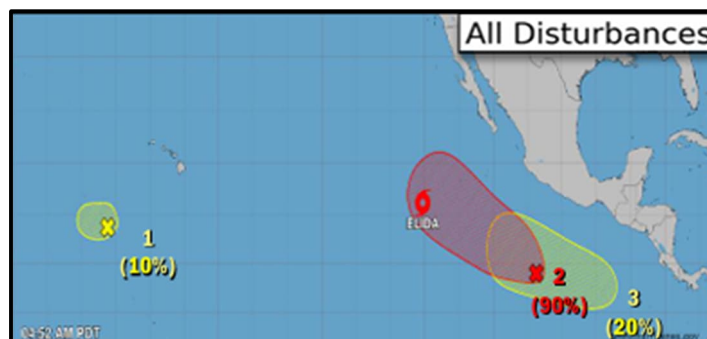
### Disturbance 2

- Located offshore of the Southeastern U.S. moving NE.
- Some gradual development of this system is possible.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)

## Tropical Activity – Pacific

### Tropical Storm Elida

- Located approximately 820 miles WSW of southern tip of Baja California moving W at 10 mph.
- Maximum sustained winds of 65 mph.
- Additional strengthening is forecast during the next day or so, and Elida is expected to become a hurricane later today.



### Disturbance 1

- Located SE of Johnston Island moving west.
- This system is expected to move into unfavorable conditions by this weekend.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (10%); 7-day: Low (10%)

### Disturbance 2

- Located SSW of southern Mexico moving WNW to NW.
- Tropical depression is likely to form by this weekend.
- Formation chance – 48-hour: High (70%); 7-day: High (90%)

### Disturbance 3

- Located well south of Mexico.
- Some gradual development possible while it moves W to WNW
- Formation chance – 48-hour: Low (near 0%); 7-day: Low (20%)
